Carbide Shop takes great care in handling your personal data. We explain why and under what conditions we gather, record and process particular personal data. You can also see what rights you have in relation to the processing of your personal data.

Personal data that we process

Carbide Shop processes your personal data because you use, or have used, our services and/or because you have supplied these to us yourself. Below you will find an overview of the personal data we process (this may apply to a greater or lesser extent):

- Name and address
- Gender, date and place of birth
- Contact details such as telephone numbers and e-mail addresses

Why we process this personal data

Carbide Shop handles personal data in full accordance with the General Data Protection Regulation. Carbide Shop processes your personal data for the following purposes:

1. For the execution of the agreement: in order to forge and maintain a relationship with you, to contact you to in order to perform our services.
2. To notify you about our services and products and any potential changes to them.
3. To continue to meet legal obligations.
4. To settle your payment.

How long we store personal data

Carbide Shop will not store your personal data for longer than is strictly necessary in order to realise the purposes for which your data is being gathered. Data that must be stored for an extended period in order to satisfy a statutory retention obligation are only deleted once this extended period has elapsed. If the agreed or statutory retention period has elapsed, the personal data is removed from the files and destroyed within a period of a year.

Sharing personal data with third parties

Carbide Shop does not sell your data to third parties and only provides it if is necessary for the execution of our agreement with you or in order to satisfy a legal obligation. We enter into a processor's agreement with companies that process your data on our behalf to ensure that your data enjoys the same level of security and confidentiality.

We use Leadinfo to measure the business visits of our website. This shows us company names and addresses based on the IP addresses of our visitors. We do not include the IP address.

Viewing, amending or deleting data

You have the right to view, amend or delete your personal data. You also have the right to withdraw your consent for the data processing or to object to the processing of your personal data by Carbide Shop and you have the right to transferability of data. That means that you may submit a request to us to send your personal data that we have in our possession to you or another organisation nominated by you in a computer file.
